CONIGLIO 2006 SAUVIGNON BLANC (NAPA VALLEY)

LEOLA is from the Latin meaning "lioness and woman of presence." Our Sauvignon Blanc is named in honor of my mother, Leola, whose uniqueness is commemorated in this wine full of complexity, grown in an alluvial vineyard in the Napa Valley and barrel aged to give the elegance only our artisanally produced wines can achieve.

The wine represents the unique potential of California Sauvignon Blanc, a ripe yet balanced wine that reflects the endless sunshine of Northern California. The wine has aromas of melon, green apple and stone fruits. The pallet is round, with bright fruit, hints of toasty oak, good acidity, and a lingering finish.
